INSTRUCTIONS FOR COACHES/INSTRUCTORS

U SPORTS has partnered with the creators of the Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT) at the University of British Columbia to create a concussion education tool for athletes.

The **CATT for Athletes** provides you with in-depth concussion education, covering:

- | What is a concussion?
- | Do I have a concussion?
- | Why is reporting important?
- | How can a concussion affect my life?
- | How do I get back to normal?
- | How can I cope with concussion?

This education module will take approximately 30 minutes to complete, includes a final assessment, and provides a certificate upon completion to you and to ISCP© & SKATZ©.

HOW TO GET CERTIFICATE

1. Take the course in either English or French:

2. Once the course is complete, you will be prompted to fill in your personal information to receive your certificate (name, email, province, etc.). In the drop-down menu for Organization, please select **International Skateboard Certification Program**.
3. Press "Download Certificate." A pop-up window with your certificate will appear.
4. You will receive an email notifying you that you have completed the course, the date you completed it, and a PDF copy of your certificate for your records. ISCP© & SKATZ© will also receive an email of each completed certificate.
